Dr Abdulrazak Ibrahim is an Associate Professor of Biochemistry, a biotechnologist, and agricultural research for development expert. He is an inventor and patent holder of RNA interference-transgenic technology for the control of whitefly in crops, the result of his work in the Brazilian Agricultural Research Cooperation (EMBRAPA Center for Genetic Resources), from where he obtained a PhD in Molecular Biology at the Universidade de Brasilia (UnB), Brazil. He also holds a Master's degree in Biochemistry from Universidade Federal do Ceara (UFC), Fortaleza, Brazil, and a BSc degree in Biochemistry from Bayero University, Kano. A multilingual Scientist, who understands Arabic, English, French, Hausa, Igbo & Portugues, Dr. Ibrahim started his career as a Chemistry Lecturer in the Jigawa State College of Education, Gumel, and later as Research Scientist in the Jigawa Research Institute (JRI) Kazuare, where he pioneered the setting up of its biotechnology program. He subsequently joined the Department of Biochemistry of Ahmadu Bello University (ABU), where he rose to the rank of Associate Professor. He has taught several courses in biology, biochemistry, plant science, agricultural biotechnology, nutrition, genetic engineering, data management, and biosafety at undergraduate and postgraduate levels.

Currently, he leads the Institutional Capacity and Future Scenario (ICF) research cluster of the Forum for Agricultural Research in (FARA), a technical arm of the African Union Commission. He coordinates the Agricultural Research and Innovation Fellowship for Africa (ARIFA), a fellowship program by FARA TETFund and Universidade Federal de Viçosa (Brazil).

He is a member of the Steering Group of African Seed Biotechnology Program (ASBP) of the African Union Commission (AUC) representing FARA; Advisory Board member of the Foundation for a Smoke-Free World (FSFW) the USA and Member Research and Development Steering Committee (RDSC) of the Tertiary Education Trust Fund (TETFund).

He is the current Editor-in-Chief of the Nigerian Journal Biotechnology (NJB).

Dr Ibrahim is a Science Communicator and mentor who has published several research papers, reviews, book chapters, policy briefs, and technical reports.

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
