He served in various capacities at home and abroad to become Nigeria's Head of Mission in Tunisia (2008/10) and later appointed Ambassador in 2011. He was Federal Permanent Secretary at the Federal Civil Service Commission, Ministry of Petroleum Resources and Nigeria's Governor to OPEC while a Member to the Boards of Nigeria LNG and Nigeria Gas until mid-2013.
